



## Basic Sewing Supplies List

### **What to bring to class:**

Your sewing machine (Recommended: Babylock BL9, available at Myers Sewing)  
Magnetic seam guide for your machine  
Thread that matches your project (Recommended: Metrosene 100% Polyester)  
Sewing scissors (Recommended: Fiskars spring loaded)  
Small scissors  
Hand-sewing needles  
Pins with long stem and pearl heads  
Pin magnet "cushion"  
Measuring tape (flexible)  
Ruler (Recommended: clear quilting style)  
Seam ripper  
Marking pen or marking chalk (Recommended: dual-end purple and blue marker)  
Pattern instructions  
Material for the pattern that has been washed, dried and pressed  
Notions associated with the project (Example: zippers, hooks and eyes, interfacing)  
A notepad and pencil

### **Additional items to have at home:**

Cutting board or surface (the fold-out cardboard type is fine)  
Iron  
Ironing board

### **Supplies and tools you can grow into:**

A bolt or several yards of 1" grid tracing material  
8 1/2 by 11 graph paper for designing patterns  
Velcro  
Snaps  
Elastic in several sizes  
Pressing cloth  
A small box or bin to store patterns  
Sewing book (Recommended: "How to Use, Adapt, and Design Sewing Patterns")  
Bobbin organizer  
Cutting table  
Dedicated sewing machine table  
Sergers sewing machine

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
